#### Our Vision

PCA is designated by Texas Education Agency as an Early College High School. This means that PCA students can begin taking dual credit classes at Angelina College beginning in 9th grade.

PARAMUS students earn high school credit while taking college classes, and can earn up to 60 college hours and an Associate's degree from Angelina College.

PCA students participate in vocational certificate programs offered at Angelina College. PCA has also contracted with the Lufkin Academy of Hair Design to offer interested students the opportunity to earn their licensure upon graduation from high school.

#### **Admissions Policy for CTE Programs:**

- 1. Request application.
- 2. Complete PAA.
- 3. Complete TSIA and pass required parts, if necessary, for enrollment in preferred CTE courses.
- 4. Have a completed/signed PGP on file for CTE Program that they are requesting.
- 5. Have completed a minimum of six high school credit classes freshman year and minimum of six high school credit classes sophomore year.
- 6. Have passed a minimum of three STAAR EOC exams or have an IGP Plan on file in counselor's office.
- 7. Student must be enrolled in a Social Studies, Math, or English class during junior year of high school.
