**Students are responsible for obtaining the book for the project. It will be counted as a major reading grade.*

- Read - **How to Be Cool in the Third Grade** by Betsy Duffey
- Written Book Report (Answer the following in a well-written report)
 - **Recall**: When did the story take place? Who were the main characters in the story?
 - **Analysis**: What caused the main problem in the story for Robbie?
 - **Comparison**: Compare Robbie and Bo before and after the problem. Why didn't Bo like his real name? Why didn't Robbie like his nickname?
 - **Inference**: How else could the problem have been solved?
 - **Evaluation**: How was the problem solved between Bo and Robbie? Was the problem solved in an appropriate way? Why or why not?
- Book Report Project (choose 1 to complete)
 - Design and create a game from the book
 - Create a movie poster of the book
 - Collage of various pictures or pieces of material to represent items from the book
- Thinking Beyond the Book (choose 1 to complete)
 - Writing: Write a new ending or write a better way to solve the problem in the book.
 - STEM: Create something to escape the bully or create a device that assesses coolness from the book.
 - Math: Develop 3 to 5 math problems involving characters and plot from the book.
