The Texas Education Agency (TEA) is now providing digital versions of student results that are readily accessible to parents. The results of all State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) assessments are available as of:

May 7 <sup>th</sup>	STAAR Grades 5 & 8 Math & Reading (April)
June 8 <sup>th</sup>	STAAR EOC Algebra 1, Biology, US History, English 1 & 2 STAAR
June 12 <sup>th</sup>	Grades 5 & 8 Math/Reading Retest (May)
June 27 <sup>th</sup>	STAAR grades 4 & 7 Writing, STAAR Grades 3-8
July 24 <sup>th</sup>	STAAR grades 5 & 8 Math/Reading Retest (June)
August 3 <sup>rd</sup>	STAAR EOC Algebra 1, Biology, US History, English 1 & 2 Retest (June)
January 18 <sup>th</sup>	STAAR EOC Algebra 1, Biology, US History, English 1 & 2 Retest (December)

To access your student's scores from a laptop, computer, tablet or cell phone:

- Go to the Texas Assessment Management System (TAMS), which is available at [www.texasassessment.com](http://www.texasassessment.com).
- Click "Log In To Student Portal".
- Click "Lookup Student Access Code." Enter your Student's **LEGAL first name only**, social security number (in the PEIMS ID box), and birth day and then click "Go" to get the Access Code.
- The Access Code will pop up. Click "Go" again.
- When you successfully login, you will see all of your student's test scores. You can click on any test to get a break down of how your student did in each area of the test, the number of questions they got correct, and the level of proficiency obtained.
- You can obtain your student's Confidential Student Report (CSR) by clicking the "Download PDF's" button on the top right of the page.

If you have difficulty accessing this information or get an error and are unable to login for any reason (e.g., an incorrect or absent Social Security Number), please contact your student's campus for help with logging in and printing out a hard copy of the report. Paper copies of the Student STAAR Report Card are available in the PCA Office.

This report will provide information about your child's current performance as well as progress from the previous year. It also includes how questions were answered, how you can provide additional support at home and resource links.
