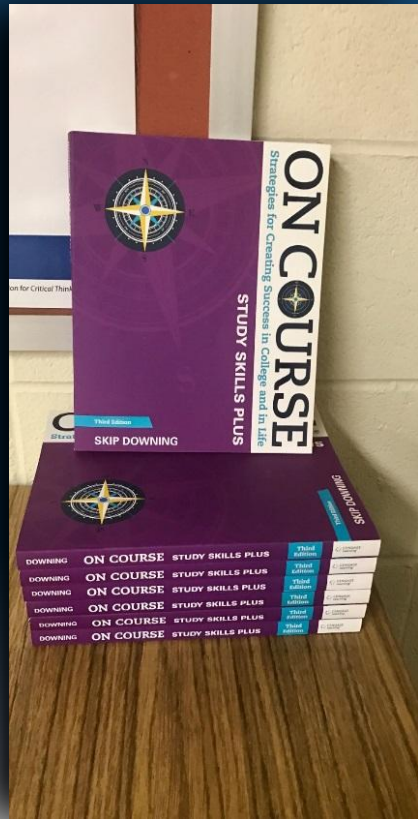




Study Skills Class
