



TSI Testing Information

- Per Texas law, students must pass at least one section of the Texas Success Initiative Assessment before being enrolled in TSI-required classes at Angelina College.
- All core classes for the general curriculum associates degree require passage of at least one section of the TSI.
- Some classes that lead to a vocational certificate do not require passage of the TSI, and may be taken as dual-credit high school electives during a student's junior and senior years.
- Students who do not pass the TSI on the first attempt may retest as long as they are working in study modules and showing improvement.
- All fees for TSI testing and retesting are paid by PARAMUS ECHS, and the ECHS principal has final determination as to whether a student may retest.



Testing Center Details

- PARAMUS has access to a full service testing facility offered through Angelina College.
- A student may test individually on Tuesdays and Thursdays at either 8:30 am or 1:00 pm, and may choose times and dates for him/her self after gaining permission from high school teachers, and TSI testing coordinator, currently Mrs. Scaief.
- Group testing is held at various dates and times throughout the year, usually on Fridays in the late Fall and Spring.
- Students should contact Mrs. Scaief (nscaief@pc charter.net or contact through [Remind](#)) to sign up individually.
- Once approved by both high school teachers, and Mrs. Scaief, students may enter the Angelina College Campus Connect and sign themselves up for the TSI following the [Online Registration/Payment Instructions](#) at the [Angelina Testing Center](#) link.
- Once you are registered for a TSI test with proper permissions, contact Mrs. Scaief the same day to complete the process.
