



Enrollment Admission Policy

Pineywoods Community Academy will accept applications for enrollment throughout the school year. If space is available, applicants will be accepted; however, if space is unavailable, applicants will be added to the current year waiting list. Current Applications will be destroyed at the end of each school year.

Each spring PCA conducts an enrollment lottery for the following school year. During the enrollment lottery window, a new application is required to be considered for acceptance in the following school year.

Open enrollment begins Monday of the first full week of school in January during the current school year and ends the last Friday of March. If the number of eligible applicants does not exceed the number of vacancies, then all eligible applicants who applied during the open enrollment time frame will be offered admission after the open enrollment period is completed. If there are more eligible applicants than available spaces in a grade, then a lottery will be conducted during the 1st week of April of the current year.

During the lottery, a name is drawn for each vacancy that is available. Each eligible applicant's name drawn will be offered admission into Pineywoods Community Academy to fill spaces in that grade level. Once available spaces are exhausted, the remaining names are placed on a lottery waiting list. PCA will notify all applicants via U.S. Mail after the drawing whether their child was accepted for the upcoming school year or placed on a lottery waiting list.
