Reports from Health Partners:

- Administration- Jennifer Shaw
Reports that Mr. George Fowler and the housekeeping staff are actively preparing for the upcoming flu season.
- Physical Education- Edwin Quarles (Athletic Director)
Elementary Students, grades 3-5, will complete Fitness gram during the Fall and Spring semesters this school year. Elementary fitness night for grades K-2nd grade is scheduled for October 23, 2018. PCA has moved to UIL division 3A. There are a total of 125-130 secondary students in athletics this school year. The first basketball game for the season on the PCA campus is scheduled for October 22nd.
- Nutritional Services- Darcy Haden
New Staff member Chef Perry has doubled staff participation in the cafeteria this school year. Salads and sub sandwiches are now being offered to secondary students. The cafeteria staff plans to allow K-2 students to sample slushes next week during Fitness night.
- Counseling- Sonya Hearne
There are 15 students participating in the Backpack buddies program at this time on the Elementary campus. Red Ribbon week is set for October 22 through October 26 this

school year. The elementary campus has 3 to 4 totes of donated uniforms left over from a recent clothing drive. ADAC has offered to store the donated uniforms in a climate control unit for PCA.

- Nurses Office- Andrea True
Staff from the In & Out Clinic of Lufkin were on campus October 12, 2018 administering flu vaccines to faculty, staff, and their children. A total of 50 vaccines were given. Staff from the In & Out Clinic are scheduled to be on site to administer vaccines during PCA's K-2nd Fitness Night scheduled for October 23, 2018. The state assigned immunization snap shot date for this school year is October 26, 2018. Harold Yost from the Lion's Club completed automated vision screenings for all PK and Kindergarten PCA students on September 27th. Vision screenings for 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th grade students are scheduled to be completed October 23 through October 25th.
- Instruction- Marla Pickard
There are no TEC changes to report at this time. Staff response to July's Living Well Aware conference has been very positive. Plans to further implement the Living Well Aware concepts will be made available by Nurse True in January.
- ADAC- Kim Simmons
Programs for 2nd and 5th grade students are in progress at this time on the Elementary campus. On the secondary campus, programs for the 9th- 12th grade students are in progress.

Mrs. Pickard inquired about preventative measures and/or parent education in regards to the polio-like virus that has been discussed in the news recently. Nurse True states that she will contact the infectious disease director for the Angelina County & Cities Health District and report back to the SHAC committee with any pertinent updates.
