Reports from Health Partners:

- Counseling- Sonya Hearne (Elementary)  
Staff reports the first round of STAAR testing was completed as on 4/9 and 4/10. Counselor has meet with several 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students to resolve behavior issues. Kim Simmons states that PCA can possibly have ADAC's , " Leo the Lion" come out and speak with the students about bullying again. The counseling department has purchased the program, "Leaving a positive footprint" and plans to implement this program next school year.
